

GARDEN GROVE A.S.A. – SOFTBALL

A. No Board Member, Manager, Coach, Player or Spectator:

1. At any time lay hand upon, push, shove, strike, threaten to strike, or verbally abuse anyone especially an official of GGASA, its representatives or any member of GGASA.
2. Be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at any time official's decision by throwing gloves, bats, balls or any other forceful action.
3. Be guilty reprobating personal verbal abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgment.
4. Be guilty of using unnecessary rough tactics in the play of the game against the body of an opposing player.
5. Be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor against any Board Member, Manager, Coach Player or Spectator.
6. Be guilty of reprobating verbal abuse upon any Board Member, Manager, Coach, Player or Spectator.
7. Use profane, obscene or vulgar language in any manner at any time.
8. Appear on the field of play or in the stands or surrounding area in an intoxicated condition.
9. Be guilty of intentionally throwing his/her bat, helmet, hat, glove, ball, etc. or using profane language that may cause dismissal from a game. Two infractions of this rule may cause player to not be considered for All Star eligibility.
10. Be guilty of discussing publicly with spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play, decision or personal opinion on other players during or after the game.
11. Speak disrespectfully to any Board Member, Manager, Coach, Player or Spectator.

B. The Umpire shall have the authority to penalize the offender according to the degree of the infraction from a warning to removal from a game and/or field area.

C. Any Manager, Coach, and/or Parent removed from the game or causing forfeit is an automatic shift in the Snack Bar, plus their one game suspension. Snack bar duty cannot be served during suspension. Snack bar duty will be served by the person who committed the infraction. Failure will result in inability to participate in any games until the duty is served.

D. Repeated violations shall result in permanent suspension from the league for the offender for a period of one year.

E. The "Disciplinary Action Committee (D.A.C.)" will review all infractions and determine the appropriate course of action to be taken.

F. All Managers and Coaches will be required to sign a "Code of Conduct" sheet and be on file with their application to become Manager or Coach of record. All managers are responsible to inform their parents of all these rules.
